<p>ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2006-01 – Fingerprinting of Defendants</p>	

One of the requirements for defendants in criminal matters before any court is that each defendant shall have a State Identification Number (SID). This SID# is obtained by fingerprinting each defendant at the time of each arrest or as ordered by the court if such case is filed by Summons and Complain with no arrest. The LiveScan technology is in place in all the jails of the 7th Judicial District and is the single best system available for the taking, recording and matching of fingerprints. Accordingly, Live Scan should be the primary, if running, system used to fingerprint defendants who are ordered to the sheriff's departments/Jails of the 7th Judicial District as per statute to accomplish this task.

If at the time of arraignment no fingerprint print order has been issued and no fingerprints have been obtained specific to the case before the court, the court shall order the defendant to report to the appropriate Sheriff's department or Jail so the fingerprinting can be accomplished according to the court order. Because of its accuracy and speed for identification, matching for purposes of disposition matching and for general public safety, LiveScan shall be used, where such equipment is operational in that county, to fingerprint all defendants ordered to complete this process by any court of the 7th Judicial District.
