ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-17 Re EXTRAORDINARY COLLECTION ACTION FILINGS PURSUANT TO SENTATE BILL 20-211.

The Colorado Legislature has enacted Senate Bill 20-211 which is now in effect and expires on November 1, 2020. Extraordinary collection action is defined by the act as an attachment, garnishment, levy, or execution to collect or enforce a judgment on a debt. Pursuant to this legislation, it is incumbent upon a judge to determine whether or not the request for issuance of a writ or legal process to effect any such extraordinary collection action complies with the requirements of this legislation. Upon the filing of any such request, the pleading will be reviewed by the assigned judge prior to filing or execution of any requested relief to assure compliance.
