

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-07 Re COVID-19 TEMPORARY MODIFIED BOND

In light of the current public health emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Court adopts this temporary modified bond schedule:

- 1) All victim notification cases will not be released until after advisement. Bond will be set by the advising Judge at advisement on a case-by-case basis.
- 2) All crime-of-violence allegation cases will have bond set per the bond schedule set out in Administrative Order 96-05 and will be advised.
- 3) Charges of possession of a weapon by a previous offender will have bond set consistent with the existing bond schedule and be advised.
- 4) All cases involving allegations of sexual misconduct will have bond set according to the existing bond schedule and be advised.
- 5) All F1, F2, and F3 bonds, as well as DF1 and DF2 bond schedule, will remain the same as under the existing Bond Order A.O. 96-05.
- 6) All Defendants arrested with multiple open cases will remain in custody until advisement, unless bond is posted consistent with the existing schedule.
- 7) All other felonies, misdemeanor, and traffic offenses will be released on a PR bond unless they have other pending cases. At advisement, the advising Judge retains the discretion and authority to modify any bond.
